### **SHOOTING STARS**

The Shooting Stars Group is an elected group of 9 young people between the ages of 11 – 18 years from across Northamptonshire. All the members have additional needs and represent either the school they attend or a service they use.

The group was developed in February 2011 and is co-ordinated by Rosie Milburn, Participation Worker for Children & Young People with Disabilities to ensure that young people that receive services from Northamptonshire County Council are involved in the planning and designing of the services.

During the Easter holidays the group went on a team building residential to Grendon Hall for two nights and enjoyed activities such as orienteering, climbing, canoeing and quad biking.

Since the group was developed, they have interviewed and recruited members of staff, helped to make sure council publicity is easy to read and understand and assisted with the re-design of youth services for disabled young people. In the near future, the group will also be involved in the buying and inspecting of services.

Members of the group will also be making a presentation at the Yurt Village launch event at Grendon Hall on Friday 8th July.

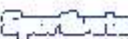
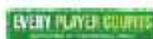
